PASTOR'S VIEW: Thoughts that I have had and things which have been brought to my attention this week...

1. Part of 'You and Yours' programme on Radio four, a feature on 'pure cremations' and the protests of children whose parents have signed up for such because they are cheaper than the full funeral, without realising that there then is no funeral and the body is often taken a hundred miles away to the firm's own crematoriums. I thought there might be a time in life when I could offer to take services without any charge, but there would still be other extra costs incurred. I'm preparing material to take a 'planning for your funeral' workshop at Lynch in the autumn.
2. In my studies in the commentary on Romans, I read this: 'Nothing good we do can make God love us any more and nothing bad we do can ever make God love us less. He died knowing every sin we would commit, and He loved us. Jesus is the only God the world has ever heard of who loves sinners.'
3. Things I have come across in my studies in reading 'The Bible in one year': 'But now this is what the LORD says: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers they will not sweep over you...". Also, 'You are all sons and daughters of God through faith in Christ Jesus, for all of you who were baptised into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.' 'The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love.' Constantly, the Holy Spirit reveals new gems to me in my studies of the Word. Yes, there is a lot to plough through, but there are so many nuggets to enjoy and appreciate.

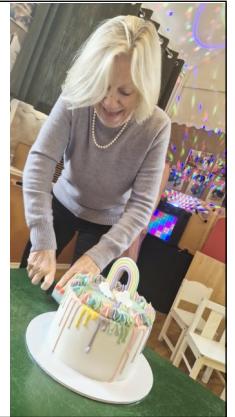
The **Duty Deacon** today will be the person who read the notices at the beginning of the service.
